1999-2000 Goals:

Establish myself, and support the technology department, as a dynamic and creative school network/computer technology resource for the Patchogue-Medford middle school faculty.

Understand the instructional aspects of the middle school ICLAS network, Windows 3.1 operating system, and currently available software, in order to train, assist, and support faculty and their students.

Work with all grade levels (six through nine), particularly the sixth and seventh grade teachers, to create a specific interest and connection, amongst colleagues, that value the student learning potential when technology supports curriculum content.

Articulate a relationship between fifth grade technology goals/skills and appropriate technology goals/skills for the sixth grade curriculum; work with the elementary staff developer to understand what goals and what skills are achieved by the end of fifth grade, and how this impacts the sixth grade use of technology.

Develop and write approximately twelve technology-in-education projects/lesson plans for the collaborative classroom that integrate learning standards.
