**AUTOCAD LT 2000** - 10-user license to begin use in Ralph's mini-lab and to install two each in the mini-lab that the ninth grade teacher uses at the other middle schools. (Towlen/Pfister) \$1689.00

From the same company/catalog as above:

**AutoSketch: Release 7** – six each of 5 station lab pack @ \$225 each (One lab @ Saxton only – Hamsch) \$1350.00

**Car Builder** - 3 lab packs @ \$195 each - one per middle school \$585.00

**Simple Machines; Teacher Edition** - 2 per middle school @ \$229 each \$1374.00

**Widget Workshop** - six copies for each middle school @ \$49.95 each \$899.10

**Gizmos and Gadgets** - six copies for each middle school @ \$89.00 each \$1602.00

**Model Smart** - 5 user - \$299.95 (\$15 each additional)

**BRIDGE BUILDER 4** –Net Pack (cat# BB-NPW ) @799.95  
Each additional copy @ \$17.50  
Requested copies for 1 lab per building (30 machines) and 6 Tech lab machines per building. (36 total per building)  
Cost per building = 1 Net Pack (799.75),  
Plus 6 add'l copies (17.50) = \$ 904.75 x 3 buildings = \$2714.25
